# TIRE TREAD DEPTH



The Safety department would like to share with you today a new and important tip to make sure you are aware of the tire tread depth requirements for the DOT. We have received a few violations on this and we need your help to make sure your tractor and trailer are following the regulations.

The DOT requires you to have a **MINIMUM** of 2/32 of an inch on your tires.

**NOTE:** It is always a good idea to buy at a truck stop the instrument that measures your tire tread so you know you're legal at all times! Is not an expensive tool and it can help you stay compliant.

**In order to avoid DOT violations, it is specifically important for you to understand that the tire tread of your tires can NOT be less than 2/32 of an inch. Therefore, it's of great importance to buy the tire tread measurement tool, you can get one at any truck stop!**
