# INTERSECTIONS



Serious accidents occur at intersections because drivers can miss a traffic light or a stop sign and collide with you at full speed. That's why you always have to be extra careful at intersections and always look right, left and right again, even if you have the right of way.

As you go through an intersection, you may have someone coming at you that maybe isn't paying attention, or is on a cell phone, so you always have to make sure that they do see you and be ready to stop if they don't, it's never a good idea to assume that since you have a big vehicle everyone sees you.

Whenever you find yourself in an intersection, always give pedestrians and cyclists the right of way, and if possible make eye contact. It is also critical to approach the intersection slowly, you never want to be caught off guard and have to slam on your brakes or find yourself without enough time to react.
