## RAIN SAFETY TIPS



Driving too fast for conditions is defined as traveling at a speed that is greater than a reasonable standard for safe driving. Wet roadways are dangerous, so you should reduce your speed by 1/3 on wet roads. Ensure that that you follow these basic precautions for Rain safety:

### **Beware of Hydroplaning**

Hydroplaning occurs when a truck hits a slick patch of rain at high speeds. To minimize hydroplaning effects, drivers should slow down, turn on the headlights to increase visibility, and create a large space between their truck and other cars.

### **Be Aware in Fog**

Fog occasionally accompanies rain. To drive safely in fog, stay alert and engage the fog lights and low-beam headlights. Never use high-beam headlights in fog. Defrost the windshields, follow the taillights of the car just ahead, and clean the lights before getting on a foggy road. If it's too foggy wait it out, fog is one of the most dangerous weather conditions.
