NIGHTTIME VISIBILITY



Inadequate visibility influences the risk of a road crash among all types of road users. Take extra precaution at night and when driving in poor light conditions that can reduce your visibility. About half of traffic fatalities occur at night. While intoxication and fatigue contribute to the high rate of nighttime crashes, nighttime driving is inherently challenging due to decreased visibility. In dark conditions, retroreflective pavement markings and signs delineate the roadway alignment and improve the visibility of decision points such as intersections, regardless it's important to take the following tips in consideration:

- Always turn your headlights on well before dusk and any time the weather conditions reduce visibility, such as rain, fog, dust and snow.
- Slow down and have the appropriate following distance.
- During your Pre-trip and along the day, make sure your headlights are working properly
- If poor weather conditions are the cause of reduced visibility consider getting off the road to a safe place until visibility improves. Many accidents involving several vehicles have Visibility to blame.
- Always reduce your speed. Don't overdrive your headlights.
