## INADEQUATE EVASIVE ACTION



As per FMCSA Inadequate evasive action may be defined as "situations when drivers fail to execute a proper evasive maneuver by not using sufficient steering inputs, not braking appropriately, or a combination of insufficient steering and braking inputs."



If you're involved in an accident and the officer believes you didn't slow down enough in advance for stopped or stopping traffic, or didn't perform steering maneuvers to avoid a vehicle or an object you will be found to be at fault of the accident.

It is always a good idea to scan your mirrors and look as far ahead as possible it is recommended at least 15 seconds in front of you, so you can safely react to changing conditions.
