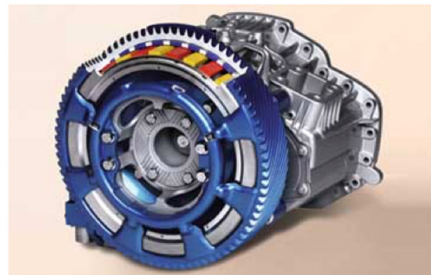


BRAKE SAFETY



The Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's Executive Director Colin Mooney unveiled law enforcement representatives will conduct a single intensive brake-safety enforcement day Sept. 7 this year instead of a Brake Safety Week which was supposed to take place September 11th to the 17th.

The law enforcement agents will be conducting inspections on CMV to look for out-of-adjustment brakes and brake system and anti-lock braking system violations, especially "loose or missing parts, air or hydraulic fluid leaks, ABS malfunction indicator lights, worn linings, pads, drums or rotors, and other faulty brake system components."



Most inspections occurring during the week will be full Level I inspections, according to the CVSA so please make sure you are fully compliant.
