## BUCKLE UP



In case of a sudden stop or crash, a safety belt will keep you secured to the seat, helping prevent injury or death that may occur from you being thrown from your seat into the steering wheel, dash, or windshield. Whether you're driving for a short or long distance or a short one you should always wear your seat belt, and if you have any passengers they must wear one too.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) noted that in 2001, safety belts saved over 12,000 American lives. Though some drivers may have excuses for not buckling up, such as thinking the belt is uncomfortable, or they didn't have to wear it in their origin countries, the data is clear that wearing your safety belt can save your life.

Not wearing a seat belt is a DOT violation in the unsafe category and subject to a monetary fine as well. Forty nine states and the District of Columbia have mandatory seat belt laws and it's a primary law in most of the country, therefore a police officer can pull you over for not wearing your seat belt without needing an additional reason to stop you.
