SPEED LIMITS



Speed is the cause of many crashes, and as a professional driver you should never speed, but surprisingly enough, more drivers are convicted of speeding than any other offense. To avoid being fined or getting involved in a crash you should always obey the posted speed limits.

Speed is a very important factor in a collision. If you double the speed of a vehicle, you increase its force of impact four times. If you triple the speed, the impact is nine times as great.



Remember that speed limits are there to show the fastest speed you may drive under good conditions, but you are responsible for adjusting your driving speed to the weather and road conditions. If the weather is bad or there is a lot of traffic, you must drive slower than the posted speed. A safe speed is the one that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle.

Keep in mind that driving too slowly is also against the Law. You should always drive with the flow of traffic (within the speed limit). You should never drive so slowly that you could block other vehicles moving at normal, safe speeds. If you do, you can cause an accident and can be issued a ticket for driving too slowly.
